## VERIFICATION OF CHILDREN ELIGIBLE FOR COVERAGE

## **Definition:**

Dependent children include you, your spouse or domestic partner's children until the end of the month that they reach age 26 which includes:

- a *natural child*, or a child placed with you for *adoption*
- a **stepchild**; or
- any other child for whom you have legal guardianship or court-ordered custody

OR

Disabled Child over Age 26 that meets certain criteria

If the employee fails to provide appropriate documentation for their child(ren), the child(ren) cannot be covered under Cascades benefits.
